IC 23.6 Read : Engine seal

Engine seals are mandatory and must not be broken or removed until the boat has been inspected at the finish.

After reaching the start area, at the latest 30 minutes after the start signal, the competitor will make the seals him/herself using the seal received during the start briefing, and he/she must send a picture of this seal immediately to the Race Management by text message or email, with the name or the number of the boat. In this photo, the seal number must be legible and show that the seal is in place.

Before arrival each boat have to ask to Race direction by text message or race commitee by VHF a code and take a photo. In this photo the seal number and the code must be legible. This photo will be send to race direction before crossing the finish line. Skipper may then break and remove the seal.

Seals (broke or non-use) will be return after dooking during technical comittee control.

IC 24.1 Read : Mandatory fixed satellite phone, in standby 24 hours a day. An external antenna is mandatory.

IC 24.2 Delete : 1 weather file in Grib format at 7.00 am UTC

Read : Each two hours fleet position reports will be available on the race FTP. The accuracy of which is the responsibility of the company OCEAN TRACKING.

IC 26 : Substitute RRS 4 par RRS 3

Add APPENDIX WP



RULES FOR WAYPOINTSWhen stated in the notice of race, races shall be sailed under The Racing Rules of Sailing as changed by this appendix.

WP1 CHANGES TO THE DEFINITIONS

WP1.1 The definition Mark is changed to:

Mark An object or waypoint the sailing instructions require a boat to leave on a specified side, a race committee vessel surrounded by navigable water from which the starting or finishing line extends, and an object intentionally attached to the object or vessel. However, an anchor line is not part of the mark.

WP1.2 Add new definition Waypoint:

Waypoint A geographic position on the surface of the water defined by WGS 84 latitude and longitude coordinates expressed in degrees decimal minutes (DDM).

WP1.3 The definition Zone is changed to:

Zone The area around a mark within a distance of three hull lengths of the boat nearer to it. The area of the zone at a mark that is a waypoint may be changed in the notice of race or sailing instructions. A boat is in the zone when any part of her hull is in the zone.
